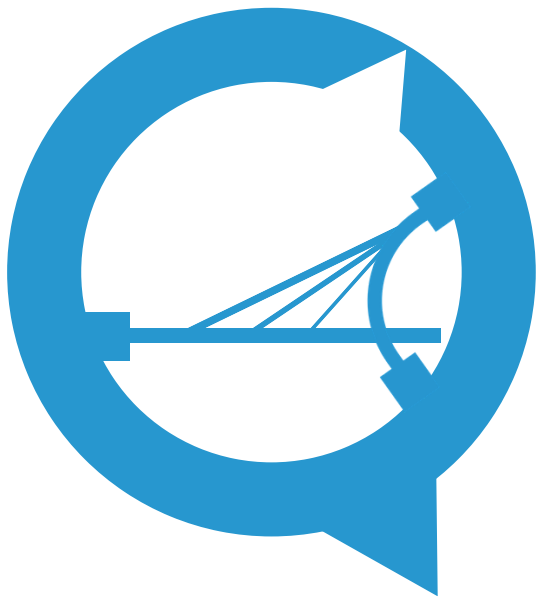

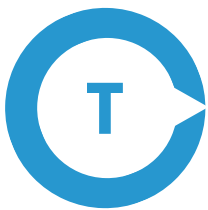

AIM OF THE CONFERENCE



The aim of the conference is to disseminate research results among young and senior researchers in the international academic environment of the Central European region, to share experience between researchers about the specific regional problems of the post-industrial society and about its adaptation to global changes, and to search ways as how to increase the competitive power of post-industrial society in the European environment.

TOPICS



The strategic document 'Regional challenges in the perspective of 2020' calls attention to substantial global based challenges of European regions. According to this strategy regions of the Czech Republic, Poland, Slovakia, or Hungary belong to highly vulnerable European regions dealing with multiple challenges (especially of globalization and energy security matter). The ways, as how to turn global changes into higher competitiveness and innovation potential, better environment and higher quality of life in Central Europe regions, will remain in the center of attention for conference participants.

- Environment and Regional Development (incl. Revitalization after Coal Mining, revitalization of Brownfields)
- Marketing and Regions (incl. Social Marketing, Marketing of Municipalities, Cities and Regions)
- Social Opportunities and Risks in the Post-industrial Region (incl. Social Exclusion, Poverty, Migration, Data Sources)
- Quality of Life (Regional Determinants, Health, Addictions)
- Section for Young Researchers (under 26 years old)

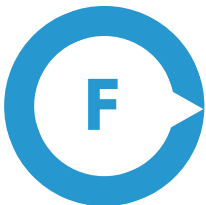
Why should you join our conference and submit your abstract?
