

AIM OF THE CONFERENCE

The aim of the conference is to disseminate research results among young and senior researchers in the international academic environment of the Central European region, to share experience between researchers about the specific regional problems of the post-industrial society and about its adaptation to global changes, and to search ways as how to increase the competitive power of post-industrial society in the European environment.



TOPICS

The theme of the forthcoming conference is multilevel governance. The papers should ideally explore one of its following dimensions while addressing the general focus of the conference on environmentally-responsible social and economic development & regional policy.

Especially the following conference topics will be discussed:

- Policy making and cross-sectoral strategies
- Vertical and horizontal relations within local governance (incl. intermunicipal cooperation)
- Public participation and transition initiatives
- Urban Mobility

Along with these conference topics, the conference traditionally provides a platform for young researchers (under 26 years old), who may submit their paper to this dedicated session. In their papers, they may address any of the aforementioned dimensions and issues related to multilevel governance.


